The Local Directory is by local people for local people.

How to use the Local Directory:

1. Consider filling out a form to be in the directory. The more people in the directory the more useful it will be.

2. Use the directory when you need something to locate it within your community. You may find that your next-door neighbor has what you need. Use the directory as a local directory of contacts, services, goods and resources like you would use the yellowpages, or the phonebook.

How to get in the directory:

1. Fill out the form in the back of the directory. You can request extra forms from the town offices or via email at [bfg\[at\]naturaldesignbuild.us](mailto:bfg@naturaldesignbuild.us).

2. Return the form to the town office in person or mail to PO Box 217, Plainfield, VT 05667

3. If you are not sure what skills you have to offer, consider *what you do* for work, what you do most of the time or what you do for other people. For example if you are an office manager for a birdhouse production shop, you could enter *office management* and/or *bird identification* if this is also one of your skills. Please look at the current directory to see what others have entered.

4. If you are not sure what resources you have to offer, consider *what you have to share*. This could be maple syrup for sale: it could be firewood for barter: it could be a dump truck for hire or it could be fabric scraps for free.

Kimchee Recipe

Ingredients: Cabbage, Onion, Diakon, Carrots, Garlic, Hot pepper, Ginger, Sea Salt, Good Water

- Chop or grate and mix into a crock.
- Fill with sea salt brine (2Tbsp salt/1qt water) to cover vegetables.
- Make sure vegetables stay under water with a plate and weight, and let sit for 1-14 days in 60 degree F. dark place, then move to cooler spot.
- Leave in crock or jar and allow fermenting gases to escape. (Screw lids on just till there is some resistance)
- Let sit in your root cellar or pantry for at least 1 month, preferably 3.


